LARGE SALE OF MULES – Messrs. Mos Clelland & Castleman, of this County, sold a lot of two year old mules, a few days ago, to Mr. James Buckalew, of New Jersey, at a very high figure. There were sixty-four in number, and the price paid for them was \$11,000 – an average of \$171 87 a head. The sale was for cash. This is the best sale, the number considered, that we have ever heard of. The mules were purchased for New York market. – – *Lexington (Ky.) Observer.*
